History of the Old Testament

Bro. Phil Johnson will take students on a journey through the historical and prophetic events of the Old Testament. This course is a freshman level course required by all majors at Providence Baptist College.

Manuscript Evidence

Pastor Jeremy Huston will begin an in-depth study of the Textus Receptus Greek text and how it applies to present-day Christians. This course is required for Pastoral Theology, Assistant Pastoral Theology, and Missions majors.

Music for the Christian

Bro. David Hallberg will explore Biblical musical philosophy and its practical application in the life of every Christian. This course is a requirement for all majors at Providence Baptist College.

Hebrews and James

Pastor Jeremy Huston will begin an exposition of the books of Hebrews and James with special attention given to Christ's divine priesthood and its correlation with New Testament Christianity. This course is a requirement for Pastoral Theology majors.

Evangelistic Song Leading

Dr. Mike Hall will lead a study on the techniques of basic conducting and congregational song leading for a balanced, evangelistic environment. This is a course taken by all Theology, Missions, and Music majors.

Bible Doctrines I

In this course, Bro. Don Ossewaarde will guide students in a study of Bibliology, Theology, Christology, and Pneumatology. This is a course required by all 4-year majors at Providence Baptist College.

Music Theory for Non-Majors

Mrs. Liz Ritchie will explain the basics of music theory for those who want to expand their understanding of music. This course is taken by Education majors and well as by Assistant Pastoral majors.

Survey of American Literature

Mrs. Pauline Putnam will take students on a journey through great American Literature from the Colonial period to the present and will provide an examination of its relationship and value to the historical period in which it was written.

Survey of Education

Bro. Don Ossewaarde will conduct a study of the historical and philosophical developments of Christian education and its methods and goals. This course is taken by Education and most ministry majors.

Survey of Romans

Bro. David Hallberg will instruct an exposition of Romans detailing the doctrines of salvation, sanctification, and service. This course is required for all Theology and Missions Majors and is a Bible elective taken by all other majors.

Business Communications

Mrs. Liz Ritchie will advance the development of students' writing skills in both the areas of business and education. This course is taken by Secretarial and Education majors.

Bible Doctrines II

In this course, Bro. Don Ossewaarde will guide students in a study of Angelology, Ecclesiology, Anthropology, Harmartiology, Soteriology, and Eschatology. This is a course required by all 4-year majors at Providence Baptist College.

History of the New Testament

Bro. Phil Johnson will take students on a journey through the historical and prophetic events of the New Testament. This course is a freshman level course required by all majors at Providence Baptist College.

Daniel & Revelation

Bro. Ossewaarde will guide a careful examination of the exemplary life of Daniel, the prophecies surrounding the End Times, the relationship between these prophecies, and how they intertwine with the book of Revelation. This course is required for all Theology and Missions majors and is a Bible elective taken by all other majors.

Microsoft Excel

Mrs. Debbie Agnew will conduct a study of spreadsheet systems for the benefit of tracking information and reports in the ministry. This course is taken by Secretarial majors at Providence Baptist College.
